Each CIT will be assigned to a grade level and will be working directly with Pastor John Smoke and others on their way to becoming a camp counselor (space is limited).

Camp Counselors!

All 10th-12th graders may apply to serve as a camp counselor. Cost will be reduced to \$285.00 and covers lodging and food. Post-high school (age 18-25) students are invited to apply to be camp counselors. Post-high counselors will receive compensation of \$100.00 for the week. Applications to serve as a camp counselor are available at the church office or on the church website. Applications are due by May 1, 2019.

A **non-refundable** \$50 deposit is due at the time of registration with payment in full due by June 24, 2019.

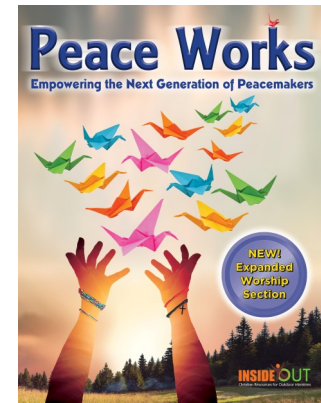
